



TOURISM COLLECTIVE BURSARY PROGRAMME

The Department of Economic Development and Tourism would like to embark on the Tourism Collective Bursary Programme. The aim of this programme is provide minimum **financial assistance** to bursary applicants that are not employees of the Department to supplement study costs towards undertaking an undergraduate full-time study in Tourism academic study fields.

All applicants are required to please carefully read through the following guidelines before proceeding with the completion of this application.

The undergraduate full-time study must take place at an Institution of Higher Education as defined in the Higher Education Act, 1997 (Act 101 of 1997). Approved financial assistance will be awarded for the **academic year 2010** towards registration and tuition fees subject to the signing of a bursary contract and the provisions of such a contract. This financial assistance will be provided in the relevant financial year.

Bursaries will be awarded on a year-on-year basis, subject to the availability of funds. Hence Bursary applications will be made available annually.

Who can apply?

- South African citizens residing in the Western Cape.
- Youth who are in Grade 12 or who have passed Grade 12.
- Students who have already embarked on tertiary studies.
- Youth Individuals who demonstrate potential in and high academic achievements
- Previously disadvantaged youth who demonstrate a keen interest in pursuing a career in the Tourism industry.

Submit:

Bursary applicants are to note that only completed applications that are submitted with required attached documentation by the due date will be considered. Section 1 of the bursary application must be completed and the following documentation must be attached:

- Course curriculum for 2010 annual studies
- Cost estimate quotation for 2010 annual studies
- Certified copy of identity document
- Certified copy of annual income of parent/s and/or legal guardian/s
- Certified copy of academic results (mid-year and/or final year results for academic year 2009 will be considered)
- Written confirmation by academic institution that applicant is accepted for full-time study at the said institution.
